Paper bags are biodegradable and an important corner stone in preserving our planet.





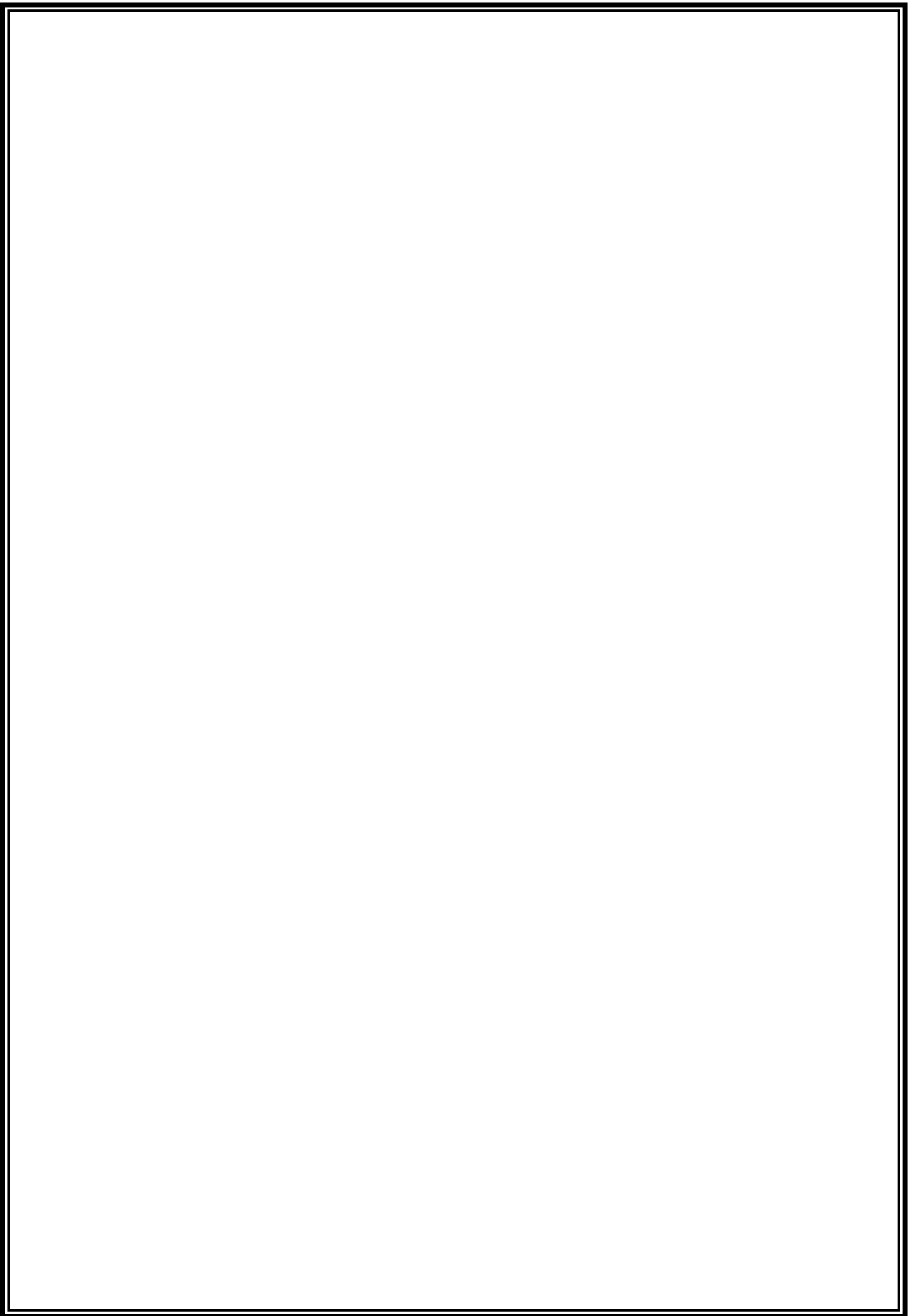

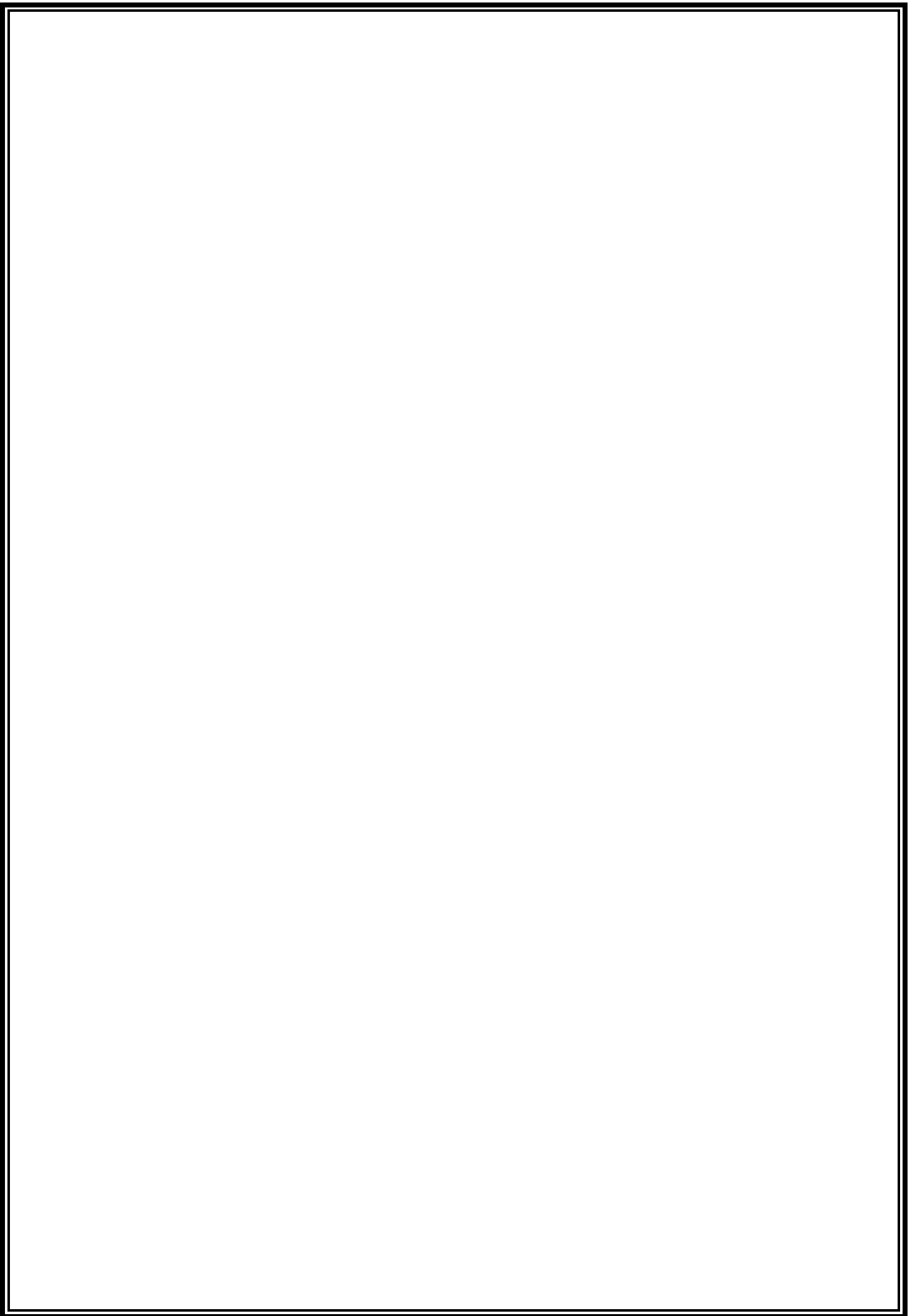
### **Objective**
