Tribute to Gen. CDS Bipin Rawat

About the program

General Bipin Rawat PVSM UYSM AVSM YSM SM VSM ADC(16 Mar 1958 – 8 Dec 2021) was an Indian military officer who was a four-star general of the Indian Army. He served as the first Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) of the Indian Armed Forces from January 2020 to December 2021. Prior to taking over as the CDS, he served as the 57th Chairman of the Chiefs of Staff Committee (Chairman COSC) of the Indian Armed Forces as well as 26th Chief of the Army Staff (COAS) of the Indian Army. This great star has fallen down on 8 December 2021, when he was enroute to Defence Services Staff College, Wellington (Nilgiri Hills), where he had to address the faculty and student officers of the Staff Course, he was killed in a chopper crash near Coonoor in Tamil Nadu along with his wife, Madhulika, and 11 more who were travelling in an IAF Mi 17 V5 helicopter.

In remembrance of this great sole NCC cadets of St. Joseph's Degree College have demonstrated their homage for this great man of adoration by lighting candles on 10th December 2021 with in the college premises. Dr.C.V.Satyanarayan Vice Principal has addressed the gathering who have united to bid their homage for this man of spirit.

Schedule: 05-April-2022

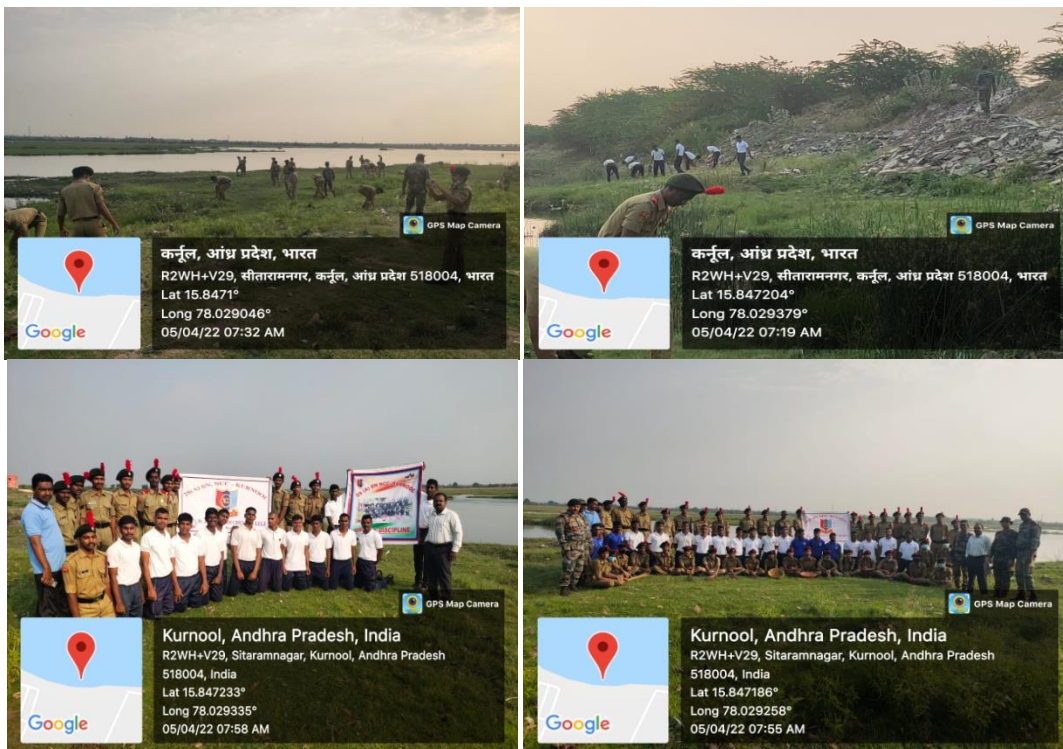
About the program
