CONSTITUTION & NCC DAY CELEBRATIONS

Schedule: 26th November 2023

About the program:

Every year on November 26th, India celebrates Constitution Day, also known as “Samvidhan Divas,” to commemorate the adoption of the Indian Constitution. Enacted by the Constituent Assembly on November 26, 1949, the Constitution became effective on January 26, 1950. Written by B.R. Ambedkar, the Constitution is recognized by American historian Granville Seward Austin as "first and foremost a social document."

A Drafting Committee, led by Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, was one of the 13 committees established by the Constituent Assembly to draft the constitution. A seven-member Drafting Committee prepared the Constitution based on the reports of these committees.

Constitution Day celebrations took place on November 26, 2023, at St. Joseph's Degree College, where NCC cadets enlightened students during the assembly about the importance of our constitution and its fundamental rights, as well as citizens' duties.

The guardians of the Constitution are the people of India, who hold sovereignty. The Constitution was drafted in their honor, giving them power. The citizens, in turn, empower the Constitution by upholding, protecting, and working diligently to increase its significance through words and actions. The Constitution belongs to everyone and no one in particular. All the NCC cadets took pride and honor in displaying the Constitution book.

About the program:

NCC Day is observed on the fourth Sunday of November. The NCC was established on July 15, 1948, in New Delhi, which coincided with the fourth Sunday of November in 1948. Therefore, NCC Raising Day is observed annually on the fourth Sunday of November in all state capitals, with cadets participating in a march past.

NCC Day celebrations were held on November 26, 2023. At St. Joseph's Degree College, NCC cadets participated in the celebration by performing a march past. As part of the festivities, Dr. K. Shanta, the Principal, handed over the NCC flag to SUO R. Chinna Ayanna, and the cadets stood in salute of the NCC flag. The program concluded with the NCC song.
