## **NATIONAL FLAG RALLY – A GUINNESS WORLD RECORD ACHIVEMENT ( 12-08-25)**

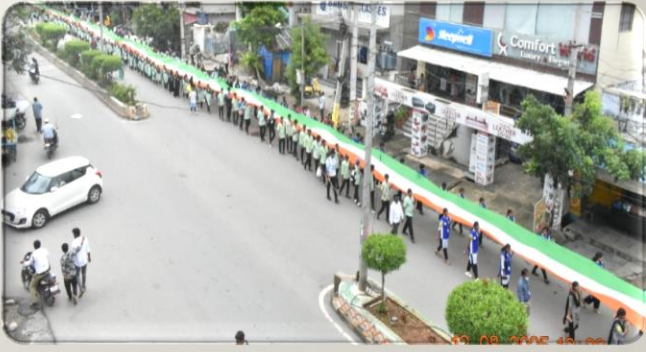
