





Environmental Awareness on Clay Ganesha

Eco club of St. Joseph's Degree College regularly conducts awareness campaigns of celebrating festivals in eco-friendly way to balance traditional and sustainability.

In recent years, there has been a significant push towards using eco-friendly materials for religious celebrations, particularly during the Ganesh Chaturthi festival.

Ganesh Chaturthi is a Hindu festival that celebrates the birth of Lord Ganesha who is known as God of Wisdom, Knowledge, Prosperity and Happiness.

The traditional practice of using plaster of paris(PoP) idols has been known to cause environmental harm due to the non-biodegradable nature of PoP, the chemical paints used and the toxic waste left in water bodies after immersion. This has led to water pollution, affecting aquatic life and water quality.

To counter this, the use of clay Ganesha idols has gained popularity. These idols are made of natural clay, which dissolves easily in water after immersion, leaving no harmful residue. Additionally, natural paints used on these idols are non-toxic. The shift towards clay Ganesha idols promotes environmental sustainability, reduces pollution and encourages responsible celebrations.

A poster presentation is a great way to raise awareness about the importance of using clay Ganesha idols. Our students displayed posters in our college like "Go Green with Clay Ganesha" to promote sustainable and environmentally conscious Ganesh Chaturthi celebrations.

- ➤ To make students aware of eco-friendly immersion and recycling of previous years decorations.
